

**THE MINES ACT, 1952-EXAMINATIONS FOR THE COAL MINES
MANAGER'S/ SURVEYOR'S/ OVERMAN'S CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY – 2009
UNDER THE COAL MINES REGULATIONS, 1957**

The Chairman, Board of Mining Examinations and Director General of Mines Safety, Dhanbad is holding examinations in December, 2009 (a) at **Dhanbad, Bilaspur, Nagpur, Ranchi, Hyderabad & Sitarampur**, centres for Mine Manager's and Surveyor's Certificate of Competency (b) at **Bhubaneswar, Dhanbad, Bilaspur, Nagpur, Ranchi, Hyderabad & Sitarampur**, for Overman's Certificate of Competency, under the Coal Mines Regulations, 1957. FEEES: (i) 1st Class Manager's Examination : Rs.100/- (ii) 2nd Class Manager's Examination: Rs.75/- (iii) Surveyor's Certificate/ Overman's Certificate of Competency examination Rs.50/- all by Bank Draft/ Indian Postal Order payable to DGMS at Dhanbad. None need apply who does not possess qualifications and practical experience in mines as prescribed under Regulation 15,16 & 17 of the Coal Mines Regulations, 1957 read with relevant bye-laws and who do not hold valid First Aid, Sirdar's and Gas-testing certificate. The validity of First Aid certificate should extend to a date, which is not earlier than the date of the examination. **No provisional certificate shall be accepted.** Practical experience prescribed under Regulation 16 & 17 of the Coal Mines Regulations, 1957 and conditions attached therewith under relevant bye-laws are as below:

Note: Candidates are required to mention the scheme and name and number of paper(s) he wishes to appear in. Application forms should specifically be obtained either from the office of THE DIRECTOR OF MINES SAFETY (EXAMS), & SECRETARY, BOARD OF MINING EXAMINATIONS, DIRECTORATE GENERAL OF MINES SAFETY, DHANBAD-826001 (JHARKHAND) by sending a self-addressed envelope (size 22 cm x 10 cm) or can be down loaded from the website www.dgms.gov.in. Every application form should be accompanied by: (i) The prescribed form duly filled in with recent attested passport size photographs affixed at the space provided therein. (ii) **DULY ATTESTED PHOTOCOPIES OF ALL CERTIFICATES SHALL BE SUBMITTED. HOWEVER, MEDICAL, CHARACTER AND PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE CERTIFICATES SHALL BE SUBMITTED IN ORIGINAL ONLY.** Other original certificates/ documents shall be required only at the time of ORAL EXAMINATIONS. (iii) Two self-addressed, stamped (**Rs.25/- each**) envelopes of size 22 cm x 10 cm enclosing **four** additional passport size attested photographs. **THE APPLICATIONS WILL BE RECEIVED BY POST ONLY AND NOT BY HAND/ PERSONAL DELIVERY. Applications, which are not properly filled in, and are not accompanied by the required documents, shall stand rejected without any reference.** All old and new candidates must submit all required documents alongwith the application to avoid rejection. **NO DOCUMENT SHALL BE ACCEPTED LATER.** Application form alongwith all required certificate/ documents should be sent to **THE DIRECTOR OF MINES SAFETY (EXAMS), & THE SECRETARY, BOARD OF MINING EXAMINATIONS, DIRECTORATE GENERAL OF MINES SAFETY, DHANBAD-826001 (JHARKHAND) BY REGISTERED POST ONLY SO AS TO REACH ON OR BEFORE 12th OCTOBER, 2009.**
