

## DGMS ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE

### DGMS HEADQUARTERS

The Organization has its headquarters at Dhanbad (Jharkhand State) and is headed by the Director General of Mines Safety (DG). At the headquarters, the Director General is assisted by specialist staff officers in mining, electrical, mechanical, occupational health, law, survey, statistics, administration, and accounts disciplines.

The headquarters has a technical library named S.S.Grewal Central Library and S&T laboratories as backup support to the organization. Due to the nature of work performed by the officers of DGMS, the Government of India declared this Organization as “S&T Institute” on the recommendation of the Science and Technology Department of the Government of India, in November 1987. Officers appointed to different technical posts in DGMS are selected by U.P.S.C. They are required to have a Degree in Mining or Electrical or Mechanical Engineering or Occupational Health and several years of experience, varying from seven to ten years of working in a responsible capacity in Mines and allied Industry. Besides officers of the mining cadre possess First Class Mine Manager's Certificate of Competency.

### FIELD ORGANIZATION

The DGMS organisation is distributed in eight Zonal offices across the country, each Zone is under the charge of a Deputy Director General of Mines Safety. There are four to six regional offices under each zonal office. Each Region is under the charge of a Director of Mines Safety/ Regional Inspector. There are in all 38 such Regional Offices. Each Zone, besides having inspecting officers of mining discipline has officers in electrical & and mechanical engineering and occupational health (O.H.) disciplines.
