In recognition of good safety performance in the mines covered under the Mines Act, 1952, the Government of India, Ministry of Labour and Employment has instituted National Safety Awards(Mines). These prestigious awards for safety of mine workers in Coal, Metalliferous and Oil mines are being presented to the mines every year since 1984 in two categories-

- i) Longest Accident Free Period, and
- ii) Lowest Injury Frequency Rate.

Online applications are hereby invited from all Owner/Agent/Manager of mines coming under the purview of Mines Act, 1952, for National Safety Awards(Mines) for the contest year 2016. The last date of filling online applications is 25.09.2017. Interested Mine management/Companies can apply online only from 01.09.2017 to 25.09.2017 and no other mode of application will be accepted. The schedule of submitting online applications is as follows :
